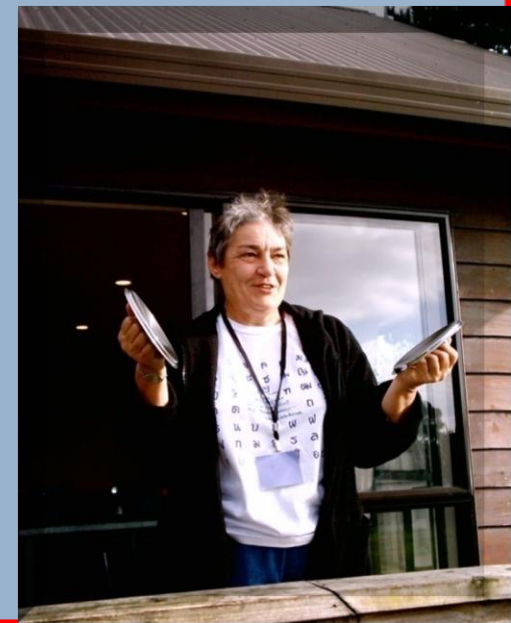
Greetings from **HFNZ**
